Tailgating Package 2019

Baldwin High School, in cooperation with the Baldwin County Board of Education, is pleased to announce a specially arranged tailgating experience for Homecoming 2019. This tailgating experience was designed with the patrons in mind. Baldwin High School, along with the Board of Education, is excited that alumni and fan groups desire to share in the Baldwin Brave Tradition. The tailgating experience will require a reservation to be made and the completion of this application packet. Tailgating will only be allowed in the designated areas. Tailgating in other areas in and around the stadium will NOT be permitted.

Tailgaters must submit the \$50 payment along with the signed disclaimer before being allowed to tailgate. (Fee applies to Homecoming Tailgating Only). This year, like last year, anyone in the tailgating area will need to purchase a wristband in order to enter into the tailgating area. Wristbands to enter the tailgate area only are \$5, people paying the \$8 admission into the game will receive a free wristband upon request. Tailgating packets will come with 5 tailgate only wristbands. WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE TAILGATE AREA, ANYONE NOT WEARING A WRISTBAND WILL BE ASKED TO EXIT AND PURCHASE ONE BEFORE THEY ARE ALLOWED TO RE-ENTER THE AREA. IF YOU PLAN TO ATTEND THE GAME AND TAILGATE YOU MUST BUY YOUR TICKET TO THE GAME, REQUEST A TAILGATE WRISTBAND, AND VISIT THE TAILGATE AREA BEFORE THE GAME. NO RE-ENTRY ALLOWED INTO THE FOOTBALL GAME. Each tailgating packet will come with a red parking permit, to be given out at the stadium on the day of homecoming, please designate a person to receive this pass when paying and picking up the packet. ONLY CARS WITH A RED PARKING PERMIT WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE TAILGATE AREA, PASSES WILL BE GIVEN OUT THE DAY OF AT THE TAILGATE AREA.

The tailgating area will open after the school day has concluded (at least 3 hours prior to game time) unless otherwise advertised. The tailgating area will close 30 minutes after the completion of the football game.

In the case of inclement weather, Baldwin High School personnel reserve the right to cancel or discontinue the Baldwin Tailgating Experience.

Tailgating Rules and Regulations

The tailgating fee must be submitted to Baldwin High School, with the application, no later than 1 week prior to the event (October 18th, 2019).

- Fees should be made payable to: <u>Baldwin High School Athletic Fund</u>, and mailed or delivered to 155 Hwy 49 W. Milledgeville, GA 31061 (All payments will be receipted)
- WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE TAILGATE AREA, ANYONE NOT
 WEARING A WRISTBAND WILL BE ASKED TO EXIT AND PURCHASE ONE BEFORE THEY ARE
 ALLOWED TO RE-ENTER THE AREA. TAILGATE ONLY WRISTBANDS ARE \$5, PAID ADMISSION TO
 THE GAME(\$8) INCLUDES A TAILGATE WRISTBAND UPON REQUEST. IF YOU PLAN TO ATTEND THE
 GAME AND TAILGATE YOU MUST BUY YOUR TICKET TO THE GAME, REQUEST A TAILGATE
 WRISTBAND, AND VISIT THE TAILGATE AREA BEFORE THE GAME. NO RE-ENTRY ALLOWED INTO
 THE FOOTBALL GAME.
- Tailgating sites (in the designated areas) are chosen on a first come/first serve basis upon arrival to the event. <u>Tailgating site has been relocated to the parking lots behind Lakeview Academy.</u>
- BHS will <u>NOT</u> provide tables, chairs, or electrical outlets.
- Propane and charcoal grills are the only permissible sources of heat for cooking. Burned coals and/or residue from cooking may not be permitted to make contact with the paved surface of the parking lot. Hot coals must be completely extinguished with water prior to leaving the tailgating site.
- No sales activities or solicitation are allowed on the Board of Education property, including any/all tailgating areas, without permission from the Superintendent or his/her designee.
- Tailgate credentials must be picked up by Wednesday, October 16th, 2019 from the Athletic Office.
- Tailgate credentials must be displayed in the window of the official tailgate vehicle or prominently displayed on the tent.
- Driving and parking on the grass is prohibited.

Tailgating

- Alcohol and tobacco use on all school properties is strictly prohibited. Violators shall be asked to leave the facilities immediately and could possibly face charges from law enforcement.
- WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE TAILGATE AREA, ANYONE NOT WEARING A WRISTBAND WILL BE ASKED TO EXIT AND PURCHASE ONE BEFORE THEY ARE ALLOWED TO RE-ENTER THE AREA.
- While we would like for you to enjoy the Homecoming/Tailgating experience, we ask that you make sure all visitors to your area maintain orderly conduct during the Homecoming/Tailgating events.
- Inform ALL members and guests in your group about these tailgating policies.
- Only designated areas may be used for tailgating.
- Tailgating in the parking lot may not impede the general flow of traffic or use a space intended for a parked car. Overflow tailgaters will be directed by security or law enforcement officers to the designated area.
- Unless special arrangements are made with the School Administration, set-up may not begin prior to the end of all school day activities for schools adjacent to the stadium.
- Driving or parking private vehicles on any or all green spaces and sidewalks is strictly prohibited.
- Tents or canopies must be secured and may not obstruct sidewalks, drive lanes or pedestrian walkways. Anchors may not be inserted in parking lot or other hard surfaces.
- Violation of these policies will cancel your groups opportunity to tailgate at future events.

Conduct

- Individuals, groups, and organizations hosting or participating in tailgate parties are responsible for their own conduct and are expected to respect the rights of others.
- Music played during tailgating must be played at a level that does not disrupt other tailgate parties.
 Explicit language is prohibited. Amplified music (including DJ's and bands) is prohibited unless otherwise approved by Baldwin County Board of Education and BHS Athletics.
- Individuals or groups engaging in inappropriate or disruptive behavior will be directed by law enforcement personnel to cease and desist from doing so and/or removed from the premises.
- Unsportsmanlike behavior may also result in removal from the facility. Participants in tailgating parties are expected to follow all policies and relevant laws.
- Failure to follow these rules and regulations may result in removal from campus and possible additional actions by school personnel and/or law enforcement.

Removal of Trash and Charcoal Fires

- Grills must be tended to at all times.
- Hot coals must be properly disposed of by tailgaters. NO DUMPING ON SIDEWALKS!
- Please bring trash bags to properly dispose of trash from your designated area.
- All leftover food/beverages must be placed in proper containers and stored.
- Areas must be cleaned and vacated within one hour after the game.

Restrooms

•	Restrooms are available inside the stadium for those who purchase game tickets. Portable restrooms will also be located in the tailgating area for anyone not purchasing a game ticket.
