Scholarship Award

- 3. Have a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale?
- 4. Submit an official high school transcript at the time of application (a final transcript will also be requested). The transcript should be mailed directly from your school to the address below or mailed by you in an envelope sealed by a school official, with the official's signature or school stamp across the sealed portion of the envelope.
- 5. Submit three (3) letters of recommendation (letters may be from a school official, church or community leader).
- 6. Submit a photograph with applicant's full name on the back of the photo.
- 7. Submit a copy of acceptance letter from an accredited College or University in the application packet.
