HOW LONG DOES THIS OPTION LAST?	BOA is a <i>permanent</i> program of the Baldwin County School District that is designed as a long-term enrollment option for students who normally require a non-traditional school setting. Families can reassess their continuation in this program at the end of each grading period.	The remote learning plan is a <i>temporary</i> solution to support the students whose parents are not comfortable having them learn on campus at this time. Families can reassess their continuation in this program at the end of each grading period. This option will dissolve once the COVID pandemic is under control and will only be used if we have an emergency school closure.
WILL MY STUDENT RECEIVE DAILY INSTRUCTION FROM A BALDWIN COUNTY TEACHER?	Yes. All core classes will have a district-provided teacher as will most electives. Once the remote learning plan dissolves, BOA instructional structure may change to accommodate the reduced student size.	Yes. ACTIVITY REQUIREMENTS

FOR BOTH OPTIONS, STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO SPEND ABOUT ONE HOUR PER CLASS PER DAY, AND ARE ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND DAILY INSTRUCTIONAL SESSIONS LED BY DISTRICT EDUCATORS. STUDENTS ARE WELCOME TO WORK AHEAD AT THEIR OWN PACE, BUT MUST AT LEAST SUBMIT ALL ASSIGNMENTS BY THEIR LISTED DUE DATES. FAILURE TO COMPLETE ASSIGNMENTS BY THE DUE DATE WILL RESULT IN ZEROS ON MISSED ASSIGNMENTS AND AN ABSENCE IN THAT CLASS.

TO CLARIFY:

THE INSTRUCTIONAL METHOD AND STUDENT EXPECTATIONS ARE IDENTICAL FOR THESE TWO PROGRAMS FOR AT LEAST THE FIRST GRADING PERIOD. THIS MAY CHANGE FOR BOA STUDENTS AS OUR TEMPORARY STUDENTS RETURN TO THEIR TRADITIONAL SETTING.
